<p>4.0 2023-2024 School Year Update</p>	<p>-Principal Murtagh provided school updates -There are many partnerships with local community colleges to provide college classes to students who have graduated -There are several upcoming school breaks around the holidays -D.C. and W.W. gave updates from the student body. Students are requesting more incentives for the point system. D.C. expressed concerns about the incident reports attached to the point system. Mr. Murtagh will follow up on these student items.</p>
<p>5.0 SPSA Review</p>	<p>-Ms. Lecy reviewed the current SPSA, including the structure that includes background, data, goals, and expenditures. -Eva Delucia-Zeltzer requested the document be sent to the entire staff. -Students gave input that they would like to see more individualization of their learning -Tiffani Mason gave input to compare the amount that is allocated to the goal with the impact on the students -For parent and community engagement, it was discussed that sometimes students have other important people who would like to get updates, but they do not because they may not hold educational rights. It was also discussed that more positive feedback for families would be good. -Tiffani Mason asked what parts of the goals they should give feedback on. Feedback is welcome on everything. The goals are tied to the LCAP, but the action items are the most specific to Mt. McKinley. -Trustee Butler gave feedback that some of the goals have multiple components that seem like two goals in one. -The SSC should review these documents and send feedback to Principal Murtagh for the next SPSA. The SSC will vote on the SPSA at the next board meeting.</p>

6.0 Safety Plan Review	<p>-Rachel Lecy reviewed the structure of the safety plan including the required components and appendices. The version on the school website is abbreviated to keep some parts of the safety plan private as recommended by the COE safety consultant.</p> <p>-The SSC will review this document prior the next meeting and give feedback to Mr. Murtagh.</p> <p>-Mr. Murtagh and Ms. Lecy will share with the SSC which parts of the Safety Plan are determined by probation and which parts the school determines.</p>

Policy approved.</p>
